

Procedures for Adopting the Guidelines:

The committee, with input from DNRC, discussed and finalized the process that would be used to formally adopt the guidelines.

1. The district's intent to discuss the CBM Protection Act Procedures and the public's right to comment will be an agenda item at the July conservation district board meeting.
2. Notice of the meeting will be provided at least in the same manner as is customary for the conservation district, and may placing a notice in the local paper.
3. The agenda will be posted seven days prior to the meeting in the places it is customarily posted.
4. A record will be kept of all attendees.
5. The draft of the procedures will be reviewed at the meeting.
6. The public will be given time to comment and the comments will be recorded in the minutes of the meeting.
7. If there are no comments, the board can make a motion to approve; if comments are made, it cannot be approved and another meeting must be held.
8. If changes are made to the procedures, Jim Rogers (406-748-3599/jdrogers@tgrsolution.net) or Laurie Kelley (406-351-1942/laurie.kelley@mt.nacdnet.net) must be notified.
9. After the procedures are approved, the minutes must be emailed to Laurie Kelley.
10. The procedures must be approved by July 31.
11. The procedures will be submitted to DNRC on August 1
